



Indure surface variation disclaimer

Indure is a unique and elegant product made from natural, recycled wood fiber. It is made by infusing medium density fiberboard, or MDF, with an acrylic polymer. This adds hardness, durability and a concrete like look that has a wide appeal. MDF is a composite wood product similar to particleboard. Each MDF board is made from waste wood fiber glued together with resin, heat and pressure.

Since Indure is a product made from recycled material, each board can consist of several different wood species, each with different densities, colors and other natural variations. Subtle surface variations that are present in the board can be magnified further after the TorZo infusion process. This results in slight color variations, or modeling, within an Indure sheet, as well as from sheet to sheet. These variations, similar to the slight color variations in concrete, are normal and not cause for concern.
