What size are Gator Skins sheets?

That standard size of Gator Skins sheets is 4' X 8'. However, custom sheet sizes of 4' X 10", 4' X 12', 5' X 8' 5' X 10' and 5' X 12' are available through special order.

What thickness are the sheets available in?

All Gator Skins sheets are .25" in thickness.

What are Gator Skins made out of?

Gator Skins are made of layers of heavy kraft paper which are saturated and cured with our proprietary PetroFree™ phenolic glue resin.

How do Gator Skins compare to competing products?

Gator Skins are equivalent in terms of wear and water resistance while vastly outperforming competing products in one key area: Surface Grip Technology. With Gator Skins, we have achieved the optimum balance of grip when needed — and the ability to easily slide and revert out of tricks when desired. Our advanced resin chemistry has been specifically formulated to provide maximum control between the layer surface and urethane skateboard wheel without compromising hardness for speed and pop. Unlike other composite surfaces, Gator Skins will never become glazed and shiny, thus avoiding the injury-causing “ice rink” effect and eliminating the need for daily mopping/maintenance. No other manufacturer can make this claim.

What colors are Gator Skins available in?

Gator Skins Indoor formulation is available in clay. Our Standard All Weather comes in tan or green (which will fade to an olive color in the sunlight over time). Our Xtra Durable All Weather formulation is available as a medium gray.

How flexible are Gator Skins?

Gator Skins sheets will bend easily, without cracking, to the radius of any skateable transition.

How do I fasten the Gator Skins to the ramp?

Gator Skins are fastened to the substrate, i.e., the plywood base layer of a ramp, with exterior grade deck screws.

Can scratches and chips be repaired?

Scratches and chips in the Gator Skins surface can be easily repaired with 2-part epoxy and a putty knife.

Will Gator Skins warp if they get wet?

Gator Skins are 100% impervious to moisture and will never warp, delaminate or degrade with any amount of exposure to water. They are designed to withstand all weather conditions and are warranted for a period of 5 years.
