

Gilasi Product Care

Gilasi surfaces are maintenance free and easy to clean.

For routine cleaning use Murphy's Oil Soap or any other mild soap or household cleaner and a dish cloth, sponge or white Scotch pad and wipe up spills as they occur.

For stubborn or dried on deposits use a cleaner/polisher like Barkeepers friend or Bon Ami with a sponge or damp cloth and rub in a circular motion.

Bleach, harsh chemicals or abrasives are not recommended for cleaning. Gilasi surfaces are heat and scratch resistant but we recommend using trivets and cutting boards to avoid excessive wear.

To restore luster apply a light layer of mineral oil as needed and wipe off excess after application or, use Tenax Tiger Ager and follow instructions on label.
